Please contact box office at time of booking if you have any special requirements.

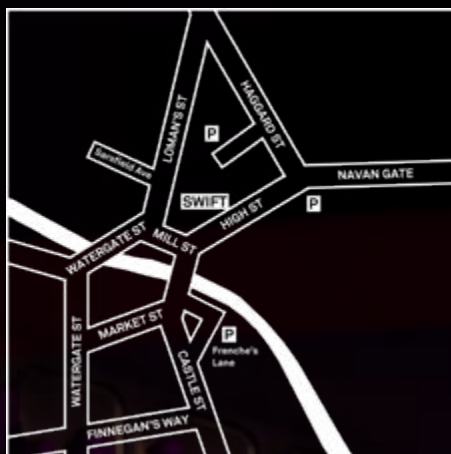
Guide dogs are welcome at Swift. Please let the Box Office know when booking your ticket so that we can arrange an aisle seat.

Where to Find Us

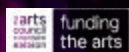
